Federal Small Business Definitions

SBA Definition of a Small Business

Defined in 1 of 2 ways...

1

Average Annual Receipts over the past three years.

2

Average Number of Employees over the past 12 months.

A Small Business concern...

- Is organized for profit.
- Has a place of business in the U.S.
- Operates primarily within the U.S.

-or-

makes a significant contribution to the U.S. economy through payment of taxes or use of American products, materials or labor.

- Independently owned and operated.
- Not dominant in its field on a national basis.

Size Standards

All federal agencies must use **SBA Size Standards** for contracts identified as Small Business.

Established in the Code Of Federal Regulations, Part 121 (13 CFR Part 121) Small Business Size Regulations.

A Small Business size standard is numerical and represents the largest a concern can be and still be considered a Small Business for Federal Government programs.

Example: Size standard for NAICS Code 238910 Site Preparation Contractors is

\$16.5M average revenue over the most recent 3 years.





Who is the NGA and what is Next NGA West?

- The National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) delivers products that provide decisive advantage to

Next NGA West (N2W) will be NGA's new state-of-the-art facility in North St. Louis. It will position NGA to better meet future mission requirements through a more robust information technology infrastructure and collaborative workspace.



Access Control Points (ACP)

Contract Award Size: Between \$1,000,000 and \$5,000,000

Anticipated Award: Spring/Summer 2022

Design-Bid-Build

Description: ACP will provide two access control points to support vehicle and personnel screening.



Visitor Control Center (VCC) – Parking

Contract Award: Between \$500,000 and \$1,000,000

Anticipated Award: Summer/Fall 2022

Design-Bid-Build

Description: VCC Parking will provide a visitor control center access drive and parking lot consisting of 350-stalls with expansion capabilities.



Remote Inspection Facility (RIF)

Contract Award Size: Between \$5,000,000 and \$10,000,000

Anticipated Award: Spring/Summer 2022

Design-Bid-Build

Description: RIF supports inspection and screening of personnel, vehicles, and cargo for all postal and service.



Landscape Construction

Contract Award: Between \$5,000,000 and \$10,000,000

Anticipated Award: Summer/Fall 2022

ODesign-Bid-Build

Description: Project will provide site-wide landscaping, including site plantings, site furnishings, landscape lighting, and irrigation.



Next NGA West Specific Contracting Notes

This is a federal contract that follows Federal Acquisition Requirements, Department of Defense, Army, Corps of Engineers and NGA rules and regulations, and has different requirements than state and private commercial contracts.

The US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is competing and awarding 4 remaining separate Small Business Construction Contracts.



Next NGA West Specific Contracting Notes

Equal Employment Opportunity

- DOL Affirmative Action Goals for St. Louis
 - Women 6.9% Participation by trade
 - Minorities 14.7% Participation by trade
- McCarthy HITT implemented a Project Specific Inclusion Plan (PSIP) that establishes specific maximum achievable opportunities for qualified minority and female participation on all aspects of construction.

Requirements to be eligible as a Prime Contractor – important for Sub-Contracting Opportunities

- System for Award Management <u>Beta.SAM.gov</u>
- Free registration required to contract with the Federal Government
- Gathers basic information to ensure eligibility for award
- D-U-N-S Number <u>www.dnb.com/get-a-duns-number.html</u>
- A Unique identification number for businesses.
- Recommend vendors register with Dun & Bradstreet for a DUNS BEFORE starting the SAM.gov registration process.
- NAICS code <u>www.census.gov/eos/www/naics/index.html</u>
 - North American Industry Classification System
- The type of work your company primarily performs.
- Search the website by key word to find your industry NAICS code.














McCarthy HITT Workforce Participation Goals
